love him or loathe him iron mike tyson is an icon and one of the most fascinating sporting figures of our time in this no holds barred autobiography tyson lays bare his demons and tells his story from poverty to stardom to hell and back again

mike atherton is the most articulate and perceptive captain of english cricket since mike brearley he was also one of the most determined batsmen of the nineties and as an opener a vital component of the england team atherton has played professional cricket for lancashire and england for 15 years despite a serious back complaint he represented england in 115 test matches and captained his country on a record 54 occasions his recovery from a difficult situation in 1995 when he was accused of ball tampering during the first test match against south africa at lord s proved a tough hurdle yet one that would strengthen his resolve his autobiography contains many serious observations about world cricket as well as humorous asides and perceptive insights into the game a born writer this is atherton in his own words

general sir mike jackson s illustrious career in the british army has spanned almost 45 years and all that time he has shown loyalty courage and commitment to

the british army whilst also being an undeniable media attraction a man of substance where foreign policy is concerned he has served in theatres from the artic to the jungle but is perhaps best known for his role in charge of the british troops to end ethnic cleansing in kosovo for assembling the british ground component of the coalition that toppled the taliban for equipping and organising the army we dispatched to defeat in iraq and for re organising the british army with aplomb his drive enthusiasm and dominating personality were always popular with his soldiers and drove him right to the top of his profession he may have been a general but he never stopped caring about the men and women in his charge despite the politics soldier the autobiography exhibits all the qualities for which jackson is admired his professionalism his honesty his directness his exuberance and his sense of humour most of all it gives a vivid sense of what modern soldiering entails

reaction had rendered him permanently hairless and his father died when he was just twelve leaving his mother alone and overwhelmed the gulf between these two sets of facts explains a great deal about nichols s transformation from lonely outsider to the center of more than one cultural universe the acute powers of observation that first made him famous the nourishment he drew from his creative partnerships most enduringly with may his unquenchable drive his hunger for security and status and the depressions and self medications that brought him to terrible lows it would take decades for him to come to grips with his demons in an incomparable portrait that follows nichols from berlin to new york to chicago to hollywood mark harris explores with brilliantly vivid detail and insight the life work struggle and passion of an artist and man in constant motion among the 250 people harris interviewed elaine may meryl streep stephen sondheim robert redford glenn close tom hanks candice bergen emma thompson annette bening natalie portman julia roberts lorne michael and gloria steinem mark harris gives an intimate and evenhanded accounting of success and failure alike the portrait is not always flattering but its ultimate impact is to present the full story of one of the most richly interesting complicated and consequential figures the worlds of theater and motion pictures have ever seen it is a triumph of the biographer s art

mike burns born hoomothya was around eight years old in 1872 when the us military murdered his family and as many as seventy six other yavapai men women and children in the skeleton cave massacre in arizona one of only a few young survivors he was adopted by an army captain and ended up serving as a scout in the us army and adventuring in the west before his death in 1934 burns wrote about the massacre his time fighting in the indian wars during the 1880s and life among the kwevkepaya and tolkepaya yavapai his precarious position between the white and native worlds gives his account a distinctive narrative voice because burns was unable to find a publisher during his lifetime these firsthand accounts of history from a native perspective remained unseen through much of the twentieth century archived at the sharlot hall museum in prescott now gregory mcnamee has brought burns s text to life making this extraordinary tale an accessible and compelling read generations after his death mike burns finally gets a chance to tell his story this autobiography offers a missing piece of arizona history as one of the only native american accounts of the skeleton cave massacre and contributes to a growing body of history from a native perspective it will be an indispensable tool for scholars and general readers interested in the west specifically arizona history the apache wars and yavapai and apache history and lifeways ☐

mike carlton was born to controversy his father jimmy a renowned olympic athlete and later a catholic priest married his mother after a whirlwind wartime courtship this scandal was hushed up at first but eventually it made headlines six years later jimmy carlton died in his wife s arms felled by asthma it was a tough beginning mike would have a sydney suburban childhood where every penny counted unable to afford a university education he left school at sixteen to begin a life in journalism that would propel him to the top as one of australia s best known media figures in an often turbulent career of more than fifty years he has been a war correspondent political reporter a tv news and current affairs reporter an award winning radio presenter in both sydney and london an outspoken newspaper columnist and a biting satirist in later life he realised a lifelong ambition to write three bestselling books of australian naval history on air is his story no holds barred with characteristic humour and flair mike tells of the feuds and the friendships the fun and the follies writing candidly of the extraordinary parade of characters and events he has encountered in the unique life he has led

from 1965 to 1973 dick butkus was the most revered player in professional football although he never played for a championship team and one can t say he set all kinds of records no other defender in the entire history of the nfl has so electrified the game the stories about butkus are legendary they make him sound so intense so ferocious and for the most part they are frighteningly true yet underneath the layers of mythology resides a man who is as thoughtful and emotional as he is intense in butkus dick butkus tells his entire life story from growing up and getting into trouble in chicago to his uncomfortable yet glorious years at the university of illinois he reveals what it felt like to be the ninth child of two hardworking lithuanian parents one of whom was born in a illinois coal mine the other never fully learned to speak english and the camaraderie and contentment he experienced while playing football he recounts the historic nine seasons with the chicago bears where he played with and against such immortals as gale sayers jim brown brian piccolo mike ditka and joe greene dick butkus looks deeply

into his own psyche to find the source of his passionate style of play a style that has often been described as violence and intimidation on the football field with honesty and emotion he recounts his battles with George Papa Bear Halas the NFL and the media
