tells the story of jean de florette a 35 year old city bred hunchbacked idealist his wife aimee and his daughter manon in the second novel manon seeks revenge for her father s death and it is she who brings the wheel full circle in a final dramatic retribution in the town square

bathed in the warm clarity of the summer sun in provence marcel pagnol s childhood memories celebrate a time of rare beauty and delight called by jean renoir the leading

film artist of his age pagnol is best known for such films as the baker s wife harvest fanny and topaze as well as the screen adaptations of his novels jean de florette and manon of the springs north point 1988 but he never forgot the magic of his provencal childhood and when he set his memories to paper late in life the result was a great new success my father s glory and my mother s castle appeared on the scene like a fresh breeze captivating readers with its sweet enchantments pagnol recalls his days hunting and fishing in the hill country his jaunts about marseilles his schoolboy diversions and above all his family his anticlerical father and sanctimonious uncle his mild and beautiful mother and many others this bright and lively book sparkles with the charm and magic that were marcel pagnol s own

shortly after albert cohen left france for london to escape the nazis he received news of his mother s death in marseille unable to mourn her he expressed his grief in a series of moving pieces for la france libre which later grew into book of my mother achingly honest intimate and moving this love song is a tribute to all mothers cohen himself expressed i shall not have written in vain if one of you after reading my hymn of death is one evening gentler with his mother because of me and my mother

since its publication in the late 1950s mountains painted with turmeric has struck a chord in the hearts of hundreds of thousands of nepali readers set in the hills of far eastern nepal the novel offers readers a window into the lives of the people by depicting in subtle detail the stark realities of village life carefully translated from the original text mountains painted with turmeric tells the story of a peasant farmer named dhané which means ironically wealthy one who is struggling to provide for his wife and son and arrange the marriage of his beautiful younger sister unable to keep up with the financial demands of the big men who control his village dhané and his family suffer one calamity after another and a series of quarrels with fellow villagers forces them into exile in haunting prose lil bahadur chettri portrays the dukha or suffering and sorrow endured by ordinary peasants the exploitation of the poor by the rich and powerful and the social conservatism that twists a community into punishing a woman for being the victim of a crime chettri describes the impoverishment dispossession and banishment of dhané s family to expose profound divisions between those who prosper and those who are slowly stripped of their meager possessions yet he also conveys the warmth and intimacy of village society from which dhané and his family are ultimately excluded

annexed by france in 1481 provence still retains its own distinct culture traditions and language while many primarily french authors like emile zola have dabbled in provencal literature this book is dedicated to those whose lives and writing careers have been devoted to this temperate and beautiful land included are analyses of the important literary contributions of groups or schools like the troubadours and the felibres poets like frederic mistral and henri bosco playwrights such as marcel pagnol novelists like alphonse daudet and more recent writers such as marie mauron and jean claude izzo photographs of many of the authors illustrate the text which includes english translations of extracts so that even readers unfamiliar with the language of provence can enjoy its literature this introduction is ideal both for those who have enjoyed the work of the featured authors before and for those who are yet to be exposed to the charms of provencal

a journey through the history cultures and societies of marseille there are many marseilles or at least many versions of marseille seaside village haven of gangsters gateway to the east city of immigrants and outcasts it is by turns the dull bourgeois provincial town where nothing ever happens and the mysterious unknowable city of the mediterranean in marseille mix william firebrace explores the many marseilles the invented and the actual leading readers down narrow streets through undulating terrain that seems at once or serially italian greek levantine and north african firebrace traces the history and culture of marseille through landscapes buildings food films literature and criminology in seven chapters in writing that is by turns essay narrative description list recipe glossary and conversation firebrace investigates the city s defining mix he tells stories of famous marseillais including marcel pagnol and antonin artaud and famous visitors including the dying arthur rimbaud and walter benjamin who wrote about one visit in

hashish in marseille he describes the brief period when marseille was the point of departure for european refugees fleeing the nazis and the city s mixture of desperation and decadence during the vichy regime he visits the basilica of notre dame de la garde and gazes down from its terrace at the panoramic view an agglomeration of neighborhoods and landscapes that became a city
