winner of an eric gregory award 2020 winner of a somerset maugham award 2020 the old shetland fishermen still speak with something like reverence of the forgotten art of steering by the moder dy mother wave the name given to an underswell which it is said always travels in the direction of home written in english interspersed with shetlandic dialect throughout this eagerly awaited debut collection from shetland poet roseanne watt contains profound assured and wilfully spare poems that are built from the sight sound and heartbeat of the land as much as from the sea in rigorously controlled concise and vivid language watt offers glimpses of the landscape alongside which we find the most complex and mysterious of human experiences

in this book sarah watts probes this dark side of the rough rider presenting a fascinating psychological portrait of a man whose personal obsession with masculinity profoundly influenced the fate of a nation drawing on his own writings and on media representations of him watts attributes the wide appeal of roosevelt s style of manhood to the way it addressed the hopes and anxieties of men of his time like many of his contemporaries roosevelt struggled with what it meant to be a man in the modern era he saw two foes within himself a fragile weakling and a primitive beast the weakling he punished and toughened with rigorous manly pursuits such as hunting horseback riding and war the beast he unleashed through brutal criticisms of homosexuals immigrants pacifists and sissies anyone who might tarnish the nation s veneer of strength and vigor with his unabashed paeans to violence and aggressive politics roosevelt ultimately offered american men a chance to project their longings and fears onto the nation and its policies in this way he harnessed the primitive energy of men s desires to propel the march of american civilization over the bodies of anyone who might stand in its way book jacket

the story onyeama had to tell was so gripping and shocking it wouldn't let me go a remarkably well written memoir bernardine evaristo from the introduction dillibe was the second black boy to study at eton joining in 1965 and the first to complete his education there written at just 21 this is a deeply personal revelatory account of the racism he endured during his time as a student at the prestigious institution he tells in vivid detail of his own background as the son of a nigerian judge at the international court of justice at the hague of his arrival at the school of the curriculum of his reception by other boys and masters and of his punishments he tells too of the cruel racial prejudice and his reactions to it and of the alienation and stereotyping he faced at such a young age a black boy at eton is a searing ground breaking book displaying the deep psychological effects of colonialism and racism a title in the black britain writing back series selected by booker prize winning author bernardine evaristo this series rediscovers and celebrates pioneering books

heretic and impostor or reformer and statesman the contradictory western visions of muhammad in european culture muhammad has been vilified as a heretic an impostor and a pagan idol but these aren t the only images of the prophet of islam that emerge from western history commentators have also portrayed muhammad as a visionary reformer and an inspirational leader statesman and lawgiver in faces of muhammad john tolan provides a comprehensive history of these changing complex and contradictory visions starting from the earliest calls to the faithful to join the crusades against the saracens he traces the evolution of western conceptions of muhammad through the reformation the enlightenment and the nineteenth and twentieth centuries and up to the present day faces of muhammad reveals a lengthy tradition of positive portrayals of muhammad that many will find surprising to reformation polemicists the spread of islam attested to the corruption of the established church and prompted them to depict muhammad as a champion of reform in revolutionary england writers on both sides of the conflict drew parallels between muhammad and oliver cromwell asking whether the prophet was a rebel against legitimate authority or the bringer of a new and just order voltaire first saw muhammad as an archetypal religious fanatic but later claimed him as an enemy of superstition to napoleon he was simply a role model a brilliant general orator and leader the book shows that muhammad wears so many faces in the west because he has always acted as a mirror for its writers their portrayals revealing more about their own concerns than the historical realities of the founder of islam

here warren kimball explores roosevelt s vision of the postwar world by laying out the nature and development of fdr s war aims his long range political goals as the face of eastern europe and the world changes before our eyes roosevelt s goals dismissed during the cold war as impractical seem less unrealistic today
