even before the emergence of the civil rights movement with black churches at its center african american religion and progressive politics were assumed to be inextricably intertwined in her revelatory book barbara savage counters this assumption with the story of a highly diversified religious community whose debates over engagement in the struggle for racial equality were as vigorous as they were persistent rather than inevitable allies black churches and political

activists have been uneasy and contentious partners from the 1920s on some of the best african american minds w e b du bois carter g woodson benjamin mays nannie helen burroughs mary mcleod bethune charles s johnson and others argued tirelessly about the churches responsibility in the quest for racial justice could they be a liberal force or would they be a constraint on progress there was no single unified black church but rather many churches marked by enormous intellectual theological and political differences and independence yet confronted by racial discrimination and poverty churches were called upon again and again to come together as savior institutions for black communities the tension between faith and political activism in black churches testifies to the difficult and unpredictable project of coupling religion and politics in the twentieth century by retrieving the people the polemics and the power of the spiritual that animated african american political life savage has dramatically demonstrated the challenge to all religious institutions seeking political change in our time

what will it take to see a fresh wave of god s power crash over the nations the earth is shaking the church is suffering from compromise and powerlessness people are desperate for solutions the answer will not come from a president it can only come from a people who know how to bring heaven to earth could it be that

forty years in the making this long awaited reinterpretation of hegel s the phenomenology of spirit is a landmark contribution to philosophy by one of the world s best known and most influential philosophers in this much anticipated work robert brandom presents a completely new retelling of the romantic rationalist adventure of ideas that is hegel s classic the phenomenology of spirit connecting analytic continental and historical traditions brandom shows how dominant modes of thought in contemporary philosophy are challenged by hegel a spirit of trust is about the massive historical shift in the life of humankind that constitutes the advent of modernity in his critiques kant talks about the distinction between what things are in themselves and how they appear to us hegel sees kant s distinction as making explicit what separates the ancient and modern worlds in the ancient world normative statuses judgments of what ought to be were taken to state objective facts in the modern world these judgments are taken to be determined by attitudes subjective stances hegel supports a view combining both of those approaches which brandom calls objective idealism there is an objective reality but we cannot make sense of it without first making sense of how we think about it according to hegel s approach we become agents only when taken as such by other agents this means that normative statuses such as commitment responsibility and authority are instituted by social practices of reciprocal recognition brandom argues that when our self conscious recognitive attitudes take the radical form of magnanimity and trust that hegel describes we can overcome a troubled modernity and enter a new age of spirit

evidence from shang oracle bones to memorials submitted to western han emperors attests to a long lasting debate in early china over the proper relationship between humans and gods one pole of the debate saw the human and divine realms as separate and agonistic and encouraged divination to determine the will of the gods and sacrifices to appease and influence them the opposite pole saw the two realms as related and claimed that humans could achieve divinity and thus control the cosmos this wide ranging book reconstructs this debate and places within their contemporary contexts the rival claims concerning the nature of the cosmos and the spirits the proper demarcation between the human and the divine realms and the types of power that humans and spirits can exercise it is often claimed that the worldview of early china was unproblematically monistic and that hence china had avoided the tensions between gods and

humans found in the west by treating the issues of cosmology sacrifice and self divinization in a historical and comparative framework that attends to the contemporary significance of specific arguments michael j puett shows that the basic cosmological assumptions of ancient china were the subject of far more debate than is generally thought

lucian pye one of the most knowledgeable observers of china unfolds in this book a deep psychological analysis of chinese political culture the dynamics of the cultural revolution the behavior of the red guards and the compulsions of mao tse tung are among the important symptoms examined but pye goes behind large events exploring the more enduring aspects of chinese culture and the stable elements of the national psychology as they have been manifested in traditional republican and communist periods he also scans several possible paths of future development the emphasis is on the roles long played by authority order hierarchy and emotional quietism in chinese political culture as shaped by the confucian tradition and the institution of filial piety and the resulting confusions brought about by the displacements of these traditions in the face of political change and modernization in this new edition pye adds a chapter on the basic tension between consensus and conflict in the operation of chinese politics illustrating the spirit in action and another discussing the great gap that persists between the worlds of the political leadership and of society at large in post tiananmen china

a provocative new way of accounting for the spirit of literary tradition still the new world makes a persuasive argument against the reduction of literature to identity questions of race gender and ethnicity

presents a collection of essays manifestos and illustrations that provide an overview of the dada movement in art describing its convictions antics and spirit through the words and art of its principal practitioners

modern philosophy finds it difficult to give a satisfactory picture of the place of minds in the world in mind and world one of the most distinguished philosophers writing today offers his diagnosis of this difficulty and points to a cure
