battlefields have traditionally been considered places where the spirits of the dead linger and popular culture brings those thoughts to life supernatural tales of war told in print on screen and in other media depict angels demons and legions of the undead fighting against or alongside human soldiers ghostly war ships and phantom aircraft carry on their never to be completed missions and the spirits sometimes corpses of dead soldiers return to confront the enemies who killed them comrades who betrayed them or leaders who sacrificed them in horrors of war the undead on the battlefield cynthia j miller and a bowdoin van riper have assembled essays that explore the meaning and significance of these tales among the questions that the volume seeks to answer are how do supernatural stories engage with cultural attitudes toward war in what ways do these stories reflect or challenge the popular memories of particular wars how do they ask us to think again about battlefield heroism military ethics and the politics of sacrifice divided into four sections chapters examine undead war stories in film carol for another christmas the devil s backbone television the twilight zone literature the bloody red baron devils of d day comics weird war tales the haunted tank graphic novels the war of the trenches and gaming call of duty world at war featuring contributions from a diverse group of international scholars these essays address such themes as monstrous enemies and enemies made monstrous legacies and memories of war and the war dead who refuse to rest drawing together stories from across wars branches of service and generations of soldiers and featuring more than fifty illustrations horrors of war will be of interest to scholars of film popular culture military history and cultural history

rudolf hoss has been called the greatest mass murderer in history as the longest serving commandant of auschwitz he supervised the killing of more than 1 1 million people unlike many of his nazi colleagues who denied either knowing about or participating in the holocaust hoss remorselessly admitted both at the nuremberg war crimes trial and in his memoirs that he sent hundreds of thousands of jews to their deaths in the gas chambers frankly describing the killing process his innovations included the use of hydrogen cyanide derived from the pesticide zyklon b in the camp s gas chambers hoss lent his name to the 1944 operation that gassed 430 000 hungarian jews in 56 days exceeding the capacity of the auschwitz s crematoria this biography follows hoss throughout his life from his childhood through his nazi command and eventual reckoning at nuremberg using historical records and hoss autobiography it explores the life and mind of one of history s most notorious and sadistic individuals

the incredibly true story of anna kashfi and her marriage to hollywood s greatest star written by film and television producer sarah broughton in october 1957 marlon brando married a young studio actress called anna kashfi he was thirty three and at the pinnacle of his beautiful fame having recently won an oscar for on the waterfront the wedding was front page news around the world his new bride was twenty three claimed to be an indian princess and was pregnant the day after the wedding a factory worker living in wales william o callaghan revealed that brando s bride was in fact his daughter joan o callaghan and had been a butcher s assistant from cardiff this book sets out to discover who was telling the truth and who was lying and perhaps more importantly why

an exploration of how espionage narratives give access to cultural conceptions of gender and sexuality before and following the second world war this book moves away from masculinist assumptions of the genre to offer an integrative survey of the sexualities on display from important characters across spy fiction topics covered include how authors mocked the traditional spy genre james bond as a symbol of pervasive british superiority still anxious about masculinity how older female spies act as queer figures that disturb the masculine mythology of the secret agent and how the clandestine lives of agents described ways to encode queer communities under threat from fascism covering texts such as the bond novels john le carré s oeuvre and their notable adaptations and works by helen macinnes christopher isherwood and mick herron sexuality and gender in fictions of espionage takes stock of spy fiction written by women female protagonists written by men and probes the representations of masculinity generated by male authors offering a counterpoint to a genre traditionally viewed as male centric sexuality and gender in fictions of espionage proposes a revision of masculinity femininity queer identities and gendered concepts such as domesticity and relates them to notions of nationality and the defence work conducted at crucial moments in history

a study of the british royal navy s activities in the indian ocean during world war ii led by admiral sir james somerville the story of the british eastern fleet which operated in the indian ocean against japan has rarely been told although it was the largest fleet deployed by the royal navy prior to 1945 and played a vital part in the theatre it was sent to protect it has no place in the popular consciousness of the naval history of the second world war so charles stephenson s deeply researched and absorbing narrative gives this forgotten fleet the

recognition it deserves british pre war naval planning for the far east is part of the story as is the disastrous loss of the battleship prince of wales and battlecruiser repulse in 1941 but the body of the book focuses on the new fleet commanded by admiral sir james somerville and its operations against the japanese navy and aircraft as well as japanese and german submarines later in the war once the fleet had been reinforced with an american aircraft carrier it was strong enough to take more aggressive actions against the japanese and these are described in vivid detail charles stephenson s authoritative study should appeal to readers who have a special interest in the war with japan in naval history more generally and royal navy in particular praise forthe eastern fleet and the indian ocean 1942 1944 this meticulously researched outstandingly clear well written and absorbing account is long overdue and will most likely become a standard work the text is most helpfully supported by over 80 pages of detailed end notes referenced to each chapter and a detailed index this is not only a book for naval historians but also for anyone with an interest in the war in the indian ocean region highly recommended military historical society i enjoyed this book it gives us an account of an often neglected part of the war at sea and of the achievements of admiral somerville who kept his fleet intact in the face of a potentially overwhelming opponent then was willing to acknowledge that his fleet needed to improve massively before it could take on the japanese dr john rickard author and webmaster of the military history encyclopedia on the
