enigma of the skies is a joint endeavor by a scientist and a photographer to present to readers everything there is to know about auroras in an easy to understand matter it explains the phenomena and describes how to predict when auroras occur using simple physics alongside a collection of beautiful photos taken both from earth and from space

with an introduction by harvard professor and author maya jasanoff taking its title from a work by the surrealist painter giorgio de chirico the enigma of arrival tells the story of a

young indian from the caribbean arriving in post imperial england and consciously over many years finding himself as a writer it is the story of a journey from one place to another from the british colony of trinidad to the ancient countryside of england and from one state of mind to another and is perhaps v s naipaul s most autobiographical work finding depth and pathos in the smallest moments naipaul also comprehends the bigger picture watching as the old world is lost to the gradual but permanent changes wrought on the english landscape it is a moving and beautiful novel told with great dignity compassion and candour

not rediscovered until the twentieth century the works of georges de la tour retain an aura of mystery at first sight his paintings suggest a veritable celebration of light and the visible world but this is deceptive the familiarity of visual experience blinds the beholder to a deeper understanding of the meanings associated with vision and the visible in the early modern period by exploring the representations of light vision and the visible in la tour s works this interdisciplinary study examines the nature of painting and its artistic religious and philosophical implications in the wake of iconoclastic outbreaks and consequent catholic call for the revitalization of religious imagery la tour paints familiar objects of visible reality that also serve as emblems of an invisible spiritual reality like the books in his paintings asking to be read la tour s paintings ask not just to be seen as visual depictions but to be deciphered as instruments of insight in figuring faith as spiritual passion and illumination la tour s paintings test the bounds of the pictorial image attempting to depict what painting cannot ultimately show words hearing time movement changes of heart la tour s emphasis on spiritual insight opens up broader artistic philosophical and conceptual reflections on the conditions of possibility of the pictorial medium by scrutinizing what is seen and how and by questioning the position of the beholder his works revitalize critical discussion of the nature of painting and its engagements with the visible world

a new york times bestseller the official book behind the academy award winning film the imitation game starring benedict cumberbatch and keira knightley it is only a slight exaggeration to say that the british mathematician alan turing 1912 1954 saved the allies from the nazis invented the computer and artificial intelligence and anticipated gay liberation by decades all before his suicide at age forty one this new york times bestselling biography of the founder of computer science with a new preface by the author that addresses turing's royal pardon in 2013 is the definitive account of an extraordinary mind and life capturing both the inner and outer drama of turing's life andrew hodes tells how turing's revolutionary idea of 1936 the concept of a universal machine laid the foundation for the modern computer and how turing brought the idea to practical realization in 1945 with his electronic design the book also tells how this work was directly related to turing's leading role in breaking the german enigma ciphers during world war ii a scientific triumph that was critical to allied victory in the atlantic at the same time this is the tragic account of a man who despite his wartime service was eventually arrested stripped of his security clearance and forced to undergo a humiliating treatment program all for trying to live honestly in a society that defined homosexuality as a crime the inspiration for a major motion picture starring benedict cumberbatch and keira knightley alan turing the enigma is a gripping story of mathematics computers cryptography and homosexual persecution

why do aircraft fly how do their wings support them in the early years of aviation there was an intense dispute between british and german experts over the question of why and how an aircraft wing provides lift the british under the leadership of the great cambridge mathematical physicist lord rayleigh produced highly elaborate investigations of the nature of discontinuous flow while the germans following ludwig prandtl in göttingen relied on the tradition called technical mechanics to explain the flow of air around a wing much of the basis of modern aerodynamics emerged from this remarkable episode yet it has never been subject to a detailed historical and sociological analysis in the enigma of the aerofoil david bloor probes a neglected aspect of this important period in the history of aviation bloor draws upon papers by the participants their restricted technical reports meeting minutes and personal correspondence much of which has never before been published and reveals the impact that the divergent mathematical traditions of cambridge and göttingen had on this great debate bloor also addresses why the british even after discovering the failings of their own theory remained resistant to the german circulation theory for more than a decade the result is essential reading for anyone studying the history philosophy or sociology of science or technology and for all those intrigued by flight

sergio moravia's *The Enigma of the Mind* originally published in Italian as *L'enigma della mente* offers a broad and lucid critical and historical survey of one of the fundamental debates in the philosophy of mind: the relationship of mind and body. This problem continues to raise deep questions concerning the nature of man. The book has two central aims: first, professor moravia sketches the major recent contributions to the mind/body problem from philosophers of mind; having established this framework, professor moravia pursues his second aim: the articulation of a particular interpretation of the mental and the mind/body problem. The book's detailed and systematic treatment of this fundamental philosophical issue make it ideal for upper-level undergraduate and graduate courses in epistemology and the philosophy of mind. It should also prove provocative reading for psychologists and cognitive scientists.

This book provides an exploration of the historical conditions that gradually defined subordinating symbols and conflictual values in social relations between the sexes. It reveals how snakes and the gelid eyes of medusa, the archetypal snake woman, have reverberated across the visual arts and written sources throughout the ages in association with negative emotions: fear, anger, scorn, and shame. The outcomes and implications of the disturbing correlation between the dangerous female gaze, the malignitas of the snake, and the lethal power of menstruation that have been woven through the fabric of the western imaginary are analysed here. This analysis reveals an intriguing history of female reptilian hybrids from the pleasing minoan snake goddesses to the depressing gorgon, echidna, amazons, eve, melusine, basilisk, poison damsel, catoblepas, and sadako samara, and gives the reader an opportunity to explore things that never happened but have always been.

Sifting the available evidence, carlo ginzburg builds up a vivid portrait of piero della Francesca's patrons and convincingly explains the contemporary intrigues resonant in his painting. This new edition, extensively illustrated, includes additional material by ginzburg dealing with the work of roberto longhi, the dating of the arezzo cycle, and the rediscovery of della Francesca in the twentieth century.

When we think of giving gifts, we think of exchanging objects that carry with them economic or symbolic value. But is every valuable thing a potentially exchangeable item whose value can be transferred? In *The Enigma of the Gift*, the distinguished french anthropologist maurice godelier reassesses the significance of gifts in social life by focusing on sacred objects which are never exchanged despite the value they possess. Beginning with an analysis of the seminal work of marcel mauss and claud   levi strass and drawing on his own fieldwork in melanesia, godelier argues that traditional theories are flawed because they consider only exchangeable gifts. in the enigma of ethnicity wilbur zelinsky draws upon more than half a century of exploring the cultural and social geography of an ever changing north america to become both biographer and critic of the recent concept of ethnicity in this ambitious and encyclopedic work he examines ethnicity s definition evolution significance implications and entanglements with other phenomena as well as the mysteries of ethnic identity and performance zelinsky begins by examining the ways in which ethnic groups and ethnicity have been defined his own definitions then become the basis for the rest of his study he next focuses on the concepts of heterolocalism the possibility that an ethnic community can exist without being physically merged and personal identity the relatively recent idea that one can concoct one s own identity in his final chapter which is also his most provocative he concentrates on the multifaceted phenomenon of multiculturalism and its relationship to ethnicity throughout he includes a close look at african americans hispanics and jews as well as such less studied groups as suburbanized japanese cubans in washington koreans lithuanian immigrants in chicago estonians in new jersey danish americans in seattle and finns reasonable nonpolemical and straightforward zelinsky s text is invaluable for readers wanting an in depth overview of the literature on ethnicity in the united states as well as a well thought out understanding of the meanings and dynamics of ethnic groups ethnicity and multiculturalism

giorgio de chirico 1888 1978 was best known for his metaphysical paintings but he also wrote poems articles about art an autobiography and the first surrealist novel even more mysterious than the paintings is the man himself secretive self centered and contradictory supercritical ironic and humorless yet creative in ways he probably hardly understood he did not share the surrealists overt preoccupation with the erotic but was obsessed with memories of ancient mythology 19th century german philosophy metaphysics and the secrets of creativity with these obsessions he tried unconsciously to solve the problems of his own sexuality which he concealed within a loner who never formally aligned himself with the surrealists or any other artistic movement he produced several thousand works of art with many changes of style these were praised by guillaume apollinaire andre breton max ernst and paul eluard he has remained one of the most baffling and memorable of those associated with the surrealists

december 1932 in the bathroom of a belgian hotel a french spymaster photographs top secret documents the operating instructions of the cipher machine enigma a few weeks later a mathematician in warsaw begins to decipher the coded communications of the third reich and lays the foundations for the code breaking operation at bletchley park the co operation between france britain and poland is given the cover name x y z december 1942 it is the middle of world war two the polish code breakers have risked their lives to continue their work inside vichy france even as an uncertain future faces their homeland now they are on the run from the gestapo people who know the enigma secret are not supposed to be in the combat zone so mi6 devises a plan to exfiltrate them if it goes wrong if they are caught the consequences could be catastrophic for the allies based on original research and newly released documents x y z is the exhilarating story of those who risked their lives to protect the greatest secret of world war two
