jackie morse kessler s riders of the apocalypse series follows teens who are transformed into the four horsemen of the apocalypse the third book in the riders of the apocalypse series loss is about a bullied teenager who s tricked into becoming pestilence a rider of the apocalypse and finds himself with the power to infect people with diseases fifteen year old billy ballard is the kid that everyone picks on but things change drastically when death tells billy he must stand in as pestilence the white rider of the apocalypse now armed with a bow that allows him to strike with disease from a distance billy lashes out at his tormentors and accidentally causes an outbreak of meningitis horrified by his actions billy begs death to take back the bow for that to happen says death billy must track down the real white rider and stop him from unleashing something awful on humanity something that could make the black plague look like a summer cold does one bullied teenager have the strength to stand his ground and the courage to save the world
