attempted to chronicle kobe s life access to a series of never before released interviews with him during his senior season and early days in the nba for a quarter century these tapes and transcripts preserved kobe s thoughts dreams and goals from his teenage years and they contained insights into and told stories about him that have never been revealed before this is more than a basketball book this is an exploration of the identity and making of an icon and the effect of his development on those around him the essence of the man before he truly became a man

paul wittek's *The Rise of the Ottoman Empire* was first published by the Royal Asiatic Society in 1938 and has been out of print for more than a quarter of a century the present reissue of the text also brings together translations of some of his other studies on ottoman history eight closely interconnected writings on the period from the founding of the state to the fall of constantinople and the reign of mehmed ii most of these pieces reproduces the texts of lectures or conference papers delivered by wittek between 1936 and 1938 when he was teaching at universit   libre in brussels belgium the books or journals in which they were originally published are for the most part inaccessible except in specialist libraries in a period when wittek's activities as an ottoman historian in particular his formulations regarding the origins and subsequent history of the ottoman state the ghazi thesis are coming under increasing study within the anglo saxon world of scholarship an introduction by colin heywood sets wittek's work in its historical and historiographical context for the benefit of those students who were not privileged to experience it firsthand this reissue and recontextualizing of wittek's pioneering work on early ottoman history makes a valuable contribution to the field and to the historiography of asian and middle eastern history generally

century

american society is often characterized as a guilt culture as opposed to non western shame cultures but is this distinction still valid today through examples like shaming penalties in criminal law fat shaming and cyberbullying on the social media the rise of the shame society america s change from a guilt culture into a shame culture shows how shame is increasingly invading our lives leading to feelings of humiliation and depression marcel van herpen identifies three causes of this phenomenon new childrearing methods the advent of the social media and a transformation of western individualism he weighs the arguments for and against a shame society and concludes that a guilt centered approach remains preferable although shame increasingly permeates everyday life the author argues that its rise is not a fatality he emphasizes that shame is a dynamic phenomenon and that one can observe trends which lead to an increase of shame as well as to its decrease examples of

the latter are a growing sensitivity to the pain caused by anti black racism the decrease of anti lgbtqia prejudices and efforts to end the stigmatization of people with disabilities along with exploring its increase the rise of the shame society demonstrates that there are ways to overcome shame

what is the alt right and how will it affect america donald trump s election as president in 2016 suddenly brought to prominence a political movement that few in political circles or the mainstream media had paid much attention to the so called alt right steven bannon trump s campaign manager was a leading figure in the movement and the election results seemed to give it a real opportunity to gain some political power but what is the alt right is it a movement a theory a trend or just an unorganized group of people far outside of what used to be the political mainstream in america or could it be all of these things why has it suddenly emerged into prominence what impact is it having on american politics today and what are the prospects for the alt right in the future through careful research and analysis the rise of the alt right addresses these and other questions tracing the movement s history from the founding of modern conservatism in postwar america to the current trump era although the alt right might seem to be just the latest extremist group to arise in the united states one likely to take its place in the graveyard of its many predecessors thomas j main analyzes evidence that the alt right is having a greater influence on the american political mainstream than did past extremist tendencies the rise of the alt right is thus an important study for anyone interested in the future of american politics and public life

today interviews proliferate everywhere in newspapers on television and in anthologies as a method they are a major tool of medicine the law the social sciences oral history projects and journalism and in the book trade interviews with authors are a major promotional device we live in an interview society how did this happen what is it about the interview form that we find so appealing and horrifying are we all just gossips or is there something more to it what are the implications of our reliance on this bizarre dynamic for publicity subjectivity and democracy literature and the rise of the interview addresses these questions from the perspective of literary culture the book traces the ways in which the interview form has been conceived and deployed by writers and interviewing has been understood as a literary critical practice it excavates what we might call a poetics of the interview form and practice in so doing it covers 150 years and four continents it includes a diverse rostrum of well known writers such as henry james t s eliot ezra pound djuna barnes william burroughs philip roth j m coetzee and toni morrison while reintroducing some individuals that history has forgotten such as betty ross queen of interviewers and julian hawthorne nathaniel s profligate son together these stories expose the interview s position in the literary imagination and consider what this might tell us about conceptions of literature authorship and reading communities in modernity

republic of china prc from 1949 to 2010 detailing each of the eleven countries ties to the prc and showing how strategic concerns associated with china s regional posture have been a significant factor in shaping their foreign and defence policies in addition to assessing bilateral ties the book also examines the institutionalization of relations between the association of southeast asian nations asean and china the first part of the book covers the period 1949 2010 it examines southeast asian responses to the prc in the context of the ideological and geopolitical rivalry of the cold war southeast asian countries policies towards the prc in first decade of the post cold war era and deepening ties between the asean states and the prc in the first decade of the twenty first century part two analyses the evolving relationships between the countries of mainland southeast asia vietnam thailand myanmar laos and cambodia and china part three reviews ties between the states of maritime southeast asia indonesia malaysia singapore the philippines brunei and east timor and the prc whilst the primary focus of the book is the security dimension of southeast asia china relations it also takes full account of political relations and the burgeoning economic ties between the two sides this book is a timely contribution to the literature on the fast changing geopolitics of the asia pacific region

this book looks at the relationship between chinese international relations ir scholarship and china s rise as a world power specifically it addresses how china s rising international status since the early 1990s has shaped the country s ir studies and the different ways that chinese ir scholars are interpreting that rise the author argues that the development of ir studies in china has been influenced by china s past historical experiences its recent change in status in world politics and indigenous scholarly interpretations of both factors instead of treating chinese ir scholars as value free social scientists the author shows how chinese scholars as purposive strategic and emotional actors tend to manipulate existing mostly western ir theories to support their policy propositions and identity statements this book represents one of few efforts to determine how local chinese scholars are constructing ir knowledge how they are dealing with intersections between indigenous chinese and imported ir theory and concepts and how chinese scholars are analyzing their china in terms of its current rise to power

the study of the growth of early christian intellectual life is of perennial interest to scholars

this volume advances discussion by exploring ways in which christian writers in the second century did not so much draw on hellenistic intellectual traditions and models as they were inevitably embedded in those traditions the volume contains papers from a seminar in rome in 2016 that explored the nature and activity of the emergent christian intellectual between the late first century and the early third century the papers show that hellenistic scholarly cultures were the milieu within which christian modes of thinking developed at the same time the essays show how christian thinkers made use of the cultures of which they were part in distinctive ways adapting existing traditions because of christian beliefs and needs the figures studied include papias from the early part of the second century tatian irenaeus and clement of alexandria from the later second century one paper on eusebius of caesarea explores the christian adaptation of hellenistic scholarly methods of commentary christian figures are studied in the light of debates within classics and jewish studies
